She then returned to her beloved hometown to teach. Her former students remember her with great fondness. She taught them the basics and how to belief in themselves, and showed them that the color of their skin did not determine their destination.

She taught at Woodsom School. Carter G. Woodsom School was the first public school for African Americans in Abilene. Established in 1890, the one-room school consisted of 22 students and one teacher it's first year. It continued being a viable part of the community until Abilene school were integrated in 1968.

In 2024 community leaders, began the task of reopening the Woodsom School for Excellence.
